

DETAILS YOU SHOULD KNOW..

*Order of classes as follows... Sat. morning we will begin with open.

Handlers meeting 7am first handler on the field 7:15.

We will move on to ranch nursery pro novice and novice will round out the day.

Saturdays trial will determine the start time for Sunday.

Sunday we will reverse the order novice.pro novice.nursery.ranch finishing off the day with open.

*Please note..nursery will only be provided should the number of dogs warrant having the class.

No limit to the number of dogs you may enter however only two may place.

*Camping is avail at the farm...no hook ups

*Coffee, tea and juice will be provided on Sat. morning along with an assortment of goodies.

There will be lunch available both days..BBQ burgers,dogs,sausage.

Beverages and snacks also.

Handlers supper on Sat.evening is \$15. per. And is a full catered meal. BBQ

Chicken and Pork..all the fixins, dessert and beverage.

Sunday morning as per usual we will offer with our compliments a breakfast egg bacon cheese bun. As well as the usual coffee tea etc..

*This is a working sheep farm, electric fence and guardian dogs present,please do not have your dogs unsupervised.

*It should go without saying that your dogs should also have current vaccinations.

*For those without GPS...from the east using the 401 go to Hwy 115

North to Lindsay/Peterborough. Exit 115 at Hwy 35 north to Lindsay.

At Hwy 7..Lindsay head west to Hwy 46/ turn at "Farmers Daughter" country store...this is a left turn/heading north.

At Woodville turn left/west to Hwy 46 again/at the United Church.

North to Lorneville...right on the Lorneville Road Shepherds Crook is on the left.

*Heading east on the 401...to Whitby/Hwy 12 north. Follow through the village of Sunderland...Head east on Hwy 7 to toward Lindsay.

Pass through the village of Manilla and turn north/left on Hwy 46 this turn is at the "Farmers Daughter" store. North to Woodville.

In Woodville turn left to Hwy 46 at the United Church...

Turn right/north to Lorneville...Turn right onto Lorneville Rd.

Shepherds Crook Farm is the first farm on the left.
