(Only 1.5 hours east of Montreal; 2 hours northeast of Burlington; VT, 4.5 hours northwest of Boston; 3 hours north of Concord, NH; 5.5 hours northeast of Albany!)

Kevin's Bio: Kevin Evans, of Pencllyn Farm in the beautiful Brecon Beacons of South Wales, has been described as 'one of the most talented young handlers of his generation.' He's a seven time member of the Welsh Team for the International and he's made it to the Supreme Championship Finals 4 times. After coming within a hair's breath of winning the coveted International Supreme Championship with Jaff if not for an argumentative ewe in the shedding ring, he did win with Jaff's son Mirk 272009 in 2008. He's won the Welsh Brace Championship (at least) twice (the first time when he was just 18 years old) and he's been the Reserve International Brace Champion. He qualified both his dogs, litter brothers, Spot and Mirk for the Double Lift Final at the World Trial in 2008. If that isn't enough, in 1994, at the tender age of 13, he won One Man and His Dog 'Young Handler' with Maid – his first trial dog given to him by Mostyn Isaacs when he was 10. Kevin's teaching style is upbeat and dynamic. He never sits still! He likes to ensure each handler/dog understands before he moves on – he spends more time with each participant than any other clinic I've ever been to!

This is why we are limiting the number of working participants – that way, every team gets a lot of one on one time with Kevin. We may charge a little more than other clinics with larger participant limits, but its well worth it! Plus, we serve GREAT food!

The 2 day clinic is for all levels – Kevin adjusts to each new dog so that everyone gets the most out of the sessions. Plus, you get to watch him work with a variety of different people and dogs.

The one day advanced shedding clinic is geared to those who want to perfect shedding skills, including sorting, what the judge is looking for and more. Open handlers – I guarantee you will learn something from Kevin!

KEVIN EVANS CLINIC REGISTRATION FORM

Clinic: \$250 CDN or USD for both days; lunch included

Advanced Shedding Clinic (dogs ready for or competing in Open) \$125 CDN or USD; lunch included

Auditing: \$60 (CDN or USD) per day (any day); lunch included.

\$15 (US or CDN) - dinner on Saturday.

Lessons - \$110 CDN or \$100 USD per hour
Clinic start time – 8:30 a.m.

Clinics: A deposit of \$100 will secure you a spot in the clinic. Limited to 10 dogs. **Balance due April 30th. No refunds after this date.** **Lessons** are payable in advance. **Reserve by March 1** with full payment – we need to know how much interest in lessons before we book Kevin’s ticket ! Important: If your lesson day is cancelled, your fee will be 100% refunded. Otherwise, **no lesson refunds after March 15th unless your spot can be filled.**

RV parking will be available – depending on the weather and condition of the field, RVs may be parked in a summer theatre parking lot (gravel), which is about a 5 minute WALK from the clinic location. No hook-ups. Motel listing available by request.
