

Training Kina June 18,19, 2022

In his attempt to cover all of the fundamentals a pup must learn to become a successful farm and trial dog, Patrick Gosselin drew from his military experience to develop a progressive training plan to get Kina from scratch to Open. He has offered to share what enabled him to qualify her for the USBCHA Nursery Finals 2021 and successfully trial her in Open at 24 months of age.

Come and spend time at Patrick's farm and let him walk you through his plan which focuses on small steps, and watch him demonstrate some of the aspects of his training. There will be an opportunity for discussion on Saturday and time on Sunday for those who'd like to try some of the techniques with their dog.

Saturday will be spent listening to, watching, and engaging in conversation with Patrick about the training program - maximum 12 handlers. Sunday will be spent with up to 8 handler/dog teams, trying some of the exercises, and up to 4 additional people auditing.

There are a number of ways you can participate. You can attend just Saturday for \$35, or attend Saturday and audit Sunday for \$50. Or you can attend on Saturday and work your dog on Sunday for \$75.

Patrick designed the program to train his young dog, but points out that the same program might be useful to handlers and dogs of any age, as they revisit and practice foundation materials.
